I went down to the courthouse Friday. I wanted to spend the entire day working down there on the Blackstone's. I want to get all the marriages copied, and xerox's of some of the originals. I started on the huge book that has the all of the marriages before 1840. The clerk told me they were in there. They weren't in any kind of order. So I started pulling them out and xeroxing them. I xeroxed mostly those around the 1850 period. The older ones, I think are possibly in another file. Years ago I had xeroxed Rebecca Newman and James Blackstone. I did not see there's in there nor Jerusha Inglett's. I started to copy the dates out of the first book, and the date they had for Jerusha's was in the 1840 period. I did not see her's either. So apparently the earlier ones are somewhere else. I got quite a few xeroxed in forty minutes. I ran across a Zephaniah Blackstone who married a lady named either Hetty, Ketty, or something else. I went through my old handwriting book, and haven't been able so far to find the letter that resembles the first alphabet of the lady. Her last name was Ellis. They were married on October 14, 1856.

Jim, I have been going over to the Aiken Public Library on the weekends when I can. Last week I came across a book that the Aiken Barnwell Genealogical Society did on the Graniteville, SC, cemetery. They have published since 1989 thousands of grave markings of Aiken County. They have three books already published. A fourth one is on the way. I went through three of them last week. These were the only Blackstone graves. Blackstone, Mattie, wife of W. A. Turner, 5 Dec. 1870 to 12 Sep. 1907. She is buried on the right side of the summer house. Blackstone, Peter, b. 1879 d. 1941. He is in section 5 of the cemetery. Blackstone, Hattie Roberson, b. 1889-d. 1962. She is also buried in section 5 in the cemetery. There is a map in the front of the book showing the sections and some history of the cemetery. I also found a book entitled Indexes to the County Wills of South Carolina compiled by Martha Lou Houston, originally published in 1939. It had Commodore D. Blackston's will in it.
