 March 20, 1862; Lieutenant Colonel; Colonel December 18,
 1863. In command of Stovall's Brigade March 29, 1865.

Pilgrim, Thomas J.- Captain March 1862. Resigned November
 11, 1862. Elected Captain of 2nd Company, 39th Military
 District Ga. Militia, March 4, 1864. Elected Colonel 1st
 Regiment Ga. Militia in 1864.

Bruton, Alberry - 1st Lieutenant March 10, 1862. Elected
 Captain. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and
 paroled there July 6, 1863. Roll for April 30, 1864, last
 on file, shows him present. Pension records show he
 surrendered at Greensboro, N. C. April 26, 1865. (Died in
 Forsyth County, Ga. April 15, 1904)

Black, Joseph R.- 2nd Lieutenant March 10, 1862. Wounded,
 foot permanently disabled at Baker's Creek, Miss., May
 16, 1863. Resigned May 30, 1864. (Born in Ga. April 27,
 1821)

Gravitt, John B.- Jr. 2nd Lieutenant March 10, 1862.
 Resigned September 2, 1862. Enlisted as a private in Co.
 G 5th Regiment Ga. Inf. February 5, 1863. Roll for
 December 31, 1864, last on file, shows him absent without
 leave since September 12, 1864. No later record.

Allen, Cyrus A.- 1st Sergeant March 10, 1862. Wounded at
 Baker's Creek, Miss. May 16, 1863. private in 1863. Roll
 for April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him on light duty
 in Atlanta, Ga. hospital. Pension records show he was
 discharged at Atlanta, Ga. April 1865. (Born in Newton
 County, Ga. March 25, 1832)

Hunt, John L.- 2nd Sergeant March 10, 1862. Wounded and
 captured at Baker's Creek, Miss. May 16, 1863, and
 admitted to Prison Hospital there, flesh wound in neck,
 in 1863. Exchanged in 1863. Wounded at Resaca, Ga. May
 16, 1864. Died, wounds, at home in 1864.

Fowler, William A.- 3rd Sergeant March 10, 1862. Wounded
 in arm, necessitating amputation above elbow, at Baker's

Creek, Miss. May 16, 1863. Discharged, disability, April 11, 1864.

Phillips, Francis M.- 4th Sergeant March 10, 1862. Wounded and captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 7, 1863. Died of wounds in Forsyth County, Ga. October 8, 1863.

Gravitt, James M.- 5th Sergeant March 10, 1862. private. Wounded in hip, and right arm permanently disabled, at Baker's Creek, Miss. May 16, 1863. (Born in Ga. October 3, 1839)

Foster, Ransom E.- 1st Corporal March 10, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, paroled there July 16, 1863, and died in hospital there in 1863.

Wallace, William M. (or Wallis) - 2nd Corporal March 10, 1862. Reduced to ranks March 1, 1864. Roll for March - April 1864, last on file, shows him absent, sick. No later record.

Black, James L.- 3rd Corporal March 10, 1862. Died in Vicksburg, Miss. hospital prior to February 23, 1863.

Hendrix, Thomas H. B. (or Hendrick) - 4th Corporal March 10, 1862. Killed at Baker's Creek, Miss. May 16, 1863.

Allen, John F.- private March 10, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, paroled there July 16, 1863, and died there in 1863.

Allen, Oliver B.- private March 10, 1862. Wounded in right side and arm at Baker's Creek, Miss. May 16, 1863. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 16, 1863. Appointed Musician. Pension records show he surrendered at Greensboro, N. C. April 26, 1865. (Born at Anderson, S. C. December 7, 1839)

Armstrong, Manley B. (or B. Manley) - private March 10, 1862. Died at Vicksburg, Miss. in 1863.

Asworth, Benjamin - private March 10, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 1863. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows he was detailed pioneer in General Stewart's Pioneer Corps. (Born in Forsyth County, Ga. in 1817)

Austin, John Henry - private March 10, 1862. Captured at Baker's Creek, Miss. May 16, 1863. Paroled at Fort Delaware, Del. July 3, 1863. Received at City Point, Va. for exchange August 1, 1863. Furloughed for 60 days by Medical Examining Board at Dalton, Ga. June 7, 1864. No later record.

Austin, Robert - private March 10, 1862. Killed at Baker's Creek, Miss. May 16, 1863.

Banister, William M.- private March 10, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 16,

1863. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him absent without leave. Pension records show he was in Dalton, Ga. hospital with pneumonia fever February 1865. Furloughed for thirty days March 1865. (Born in Dawson County, Ga. in 1835)

Barrett, Alfred W.- private March 10, 1862. Captured in 1862. Exchanged at Vicksburg, Miss. November 15, 1862. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him absent without leave. No later record.

Beachum, James A.- private August 20, 1862. Roll dated November 12, 1862, only roll on which borne, shows him present.

Beachum, James H.- private March 10, 1862. Appointed 3rd Corporal May 1863. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 10, 1863. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him present. Pension records show he enlisted in "Graham's Battn. Militia March 1865, and surrendered at Kingston, Ga. May 12, 1865 ." (Born in Greenville, S. C. November 18, 1840)

Beachum, W. A.- private March 10, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 10, 1863. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him present. No later record.

Bell, Hiram P.- private March 10, 1862. Elected Lieutenant Colonel March 20, 1862. Wounded in left leg below knee at Chickasaw Bayou, Miss. December 29, 1862. Elected Colonel May 1863. Resigned, Special Order #2164, December 18, 1863. (Born in Ga. March 19, 1827)

Bell, John F.- private March 10, 1862. Killed at Resaca, Ga. May 14, 1864.

Bell, J. W.- private August 20, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 1863. Surrendered at Greensboro, N. C. April 26, 1865.

Bell, T. J.- private August 14, 1862. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him present. Died in Tennessee hospital.

Bennett, Andrew J.- private March 10, 1862. Appointed 5th Sergeant May 1863. Captured at Baker's Creek, Miss. May 17, 1863. Paroled at Fort Delaware, Del. July 3, 1863. Received at City Point, Va. for exchange July 6, 1863. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him present. Furloughed for 60 days from Camp Hospital near Atlanta, Ga. July 15, 1864. Pension records show he enlisted in Powell's Company Ga. Militia Cavalry while home on furlough, unable to reach command, in 1864. Surrendered at Kingston, Ga. May 12, 1865. (Born in Forsyth County, Ga. August 15, 1837. Died in Fulton County, Ga. in 1923)

Bennett, Thomas Richard - private March 10, 1862. Wounded near Chattanooga, Tenn. June 1862. Surrendered at

Greensboro, N. C. April 26, 1865. (Born in Forsyth County, Ga. March 31, 1838. Died in 1918)

Bennett, William - private August 13, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 6, 1863. No later record.

Blackston, Francis M. (or Blackstone) - private March 10, 1862. Died June 21, 1862.

Bond, Thomas H.- private March 10, 1862. Died in Lauderdale Springs, Miss. hospital April 23, 1863.

Brewton, Enoch, Jr.- See Bruton.

Brown, Berrien H.- private March 10, 1862. Appointed Hospital Steward June 1862. Surrendered at Greensboro, N. C. April 26, 1865. (Born at Gainesville, Ga. May 8, 1838)

Bruce, Killis Ramsey - private March 10, 1862. Died of chronic diarrhoea in 1st Mississippi C. S. A. Hospital at Jackson, Miss. June 5, 1863.

Bruton, Enoch, Jr.- private January 14, 1863. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him absent, sent to hospital October 8, 1863. No later record.

Burruss, Mark B.- private March 10, 1862. Appointed 4th Sergeant May 1863. Wounded at Baker's Creek, Miss. May 16, 1863. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863. Died in Tennessee in 1864.

Cantrell, B. F.- private March 10, 1862. Died of disease at Vicksburg, Miss. in 1863.

Carlisle, Joseph R.- private March 10, 1862. Died at Vicksburg, Miss.

Chambers, Berry - private August 20, 1862. Captured at Baker's Creek, Miss. May 17, 1863, and sent to Camp Morton, Ind. in 1863.

Chambers, John B.- private March 10, 1862. Captured and paroled at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863. Furloughed for 30 days July 21, 1863. Transferred to Co. H Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him absent without leave. Pension records show he was unfit for further service. Paroled at Atlanta, Ga. May 17, 1865. (Born in Ga. January 2, 1834)

Cheek, Russell H.- private March 10, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 6, 1863. Transferred to Co. G March 1, 1864. No later record.

Coleman, General W. (or George W.) - private March 10, 1862. Died in hospital June 21, 1862.

Compton, Newton J.- private March 10, 1862. Died in Atlanta, Ga. hospital July 15, 1862.

Compton, Philo H.- private March 10, 1862. Died of chronic diarrhoea in Confederate States Hospital at Petersburg, Va. August 2, 1863.

Cross, Gideon - private March 10, 1862. Died of fever in Fair Grounds Hospital at Knoxville, Tenn. November 26, 1862.

Crow, Coleman C.- private March 10, 1862. Transferred to Co. D 36th Regiment Ga. Inf. in 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 9, 1863. Captured at Dalton, Ga. May 12, 1864. Took oath of allegiance to U. S. Govt. at Camp Morton, Ind. June 3, 1864; remarks: "Claims always to have been loyal. Gave himself up. Wishes to take oath and go to New York." Took oath of allegiance to U. S. Govt. at Camp Morton, Ind. and released October 16, 1864.

Crow, James E.- private February 10, 1863. Appointed Sergeant in 1863. Wounded in right side and left chest, permanently disabled and captured, at Baker's Creek, Miss. May 16, 1863. Exchanged in 1863. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him absent without leave. (Born in Ga. June 26, 1824)

Crow, John B.- private March 10, 1862. Captured at Baker's Creek, Miss. May 16, 1863. Released at Point Lookout, Md. June 26, 1865.

Crow, Jonathan H.- private March 10, 1862. Appointed Sergeant. Wounded, left leg disabled, at Baker's Creek, Miss. May 16, 1863. (Resident of Ga. since 1842)

Crow, William C.- private March 10, 1862. Wounded in left leg at Baker's Creek, Miss. May 16, 1863. Appointed 1st Corporal May 1863. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 7, 1863. Wounded in mouth, right jaw bone broken, at Jonesboro, Ga. August 31, 1864.

Denning, Valentine W.- private March 10, 1862. Appointed Regimental Musician. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 6, 1863. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him present. No later record.

Driscoll, Washington T.- private March 10, 1862. Died of disease in Kingston, Ga. hospital February 13, 1864.

Dunaway, John - private March 10, 1862. Captured at Baker's Creek, Miss. May 16, 1863. Paroled at Fort Delaware, Del. in 1863. Received at City Point, Va. for exchange July 6, 1863. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him present. Pension records show he was paroled at Kingston, Ga. May 15, 1865. (Born in Walton County, Ga. in 1829)

Echols, Columbus D.- private March 10, 1862. Wounded and captured at Baker's Creek, Miss. May 16, 1863. In Breckinridge's Division Hospital at Marion, Miss. October

1863. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him an Marietta, Ga. hospital.

Echols, Joshua - private May 3, 1862. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him present. No later record.

Ellis, John W.- private March 10, 1862. Died of brain fever in Tazewell, Tenn. hospital August 28 or September 5, 1862.

Evelt, L. K.- private May 3, 1862. Roll dated November 11, 1862, only one on which borne, shows him present.

Flynn, Joseph E.- private March 10, 1862. Captured at Baker's Creek, Miss. May 16, 1863. Died of disease at Fort Delaware, Del. July 8, 1863.

Foster, Green B.- private March 10, 1862. Appointed Regimental Musician. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 6, 1863. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him absent without leave. No later record.

Gazaway, J. M.- private August 13, 1862. Died in Fair Grounds Hospital at Atlanta, Ga. December 7, 1862. Buried there in Oakland Cemetery.

Goolsby, John L.- private March 10, 1862. Captured at Baker's Creek, Miss. May 16, 1863. Union prisoner of war records show he 'Died July 1, 1863. in Illinois, while a prisoner.' " "Final statement, signed by 1st Lieutenant Alberry Bruton, show he 'Died July 1, 1863. in Illinois, while a prisoner." Claim was filed by his mother February 11, 1864, stating that he "Died on or about July 1, 1863." (Above soldier was born in Oglethorpe County, Ga. October 8, 1844. Entered Confederate Soldiers' Home at Atlanta, Ga. May 24, 1928. Discharged from Home August 20, 1923)

Graham, James D.- private May 15, 1862. Roll dated November 11, 1862, only one on which borne, shows him present.

Graham, William L.- private March 10, 1862. Elected Captain. Captured at Baker's Creek, Miss. May 16, 1863. Paroled at Johnson's Island, O. and forwarded to Point Lookout, Md. for exchange February 20, 1865.

Gravitt, Cicero - private March 10, 1862. Captured in 1862. Sent from Lexington, Ky. to Louisville, Ky. October 23, 1862. Died in Tennessee in 1863.

Gravitt, James W. (or Thomas W.) - private March 10, 1862. Appointed Corporal in 1862. Died in Forsyth County, Ga. April 30, 1862.

Gravitt, Robert R.- private October 27, 1862. Substitute for Abijah J. Julian. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 16, 1863. Died in Forsyth

County, Ga. August 20, 1863.

Hames, Henry Milton - private March 10, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss., July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 6, 1863. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him present. No later record.

Hames, Robert Asberry - private March 10, 1862. In French's Division Hospital at Enterprise, Miss. June 30, 1863. Died in 1863.

Hammond, Marion - private March 10, 1862. Captured at Baker's Creek, Miss. May 16, 1863. Sent from Camp Morton, Ind. to Fort Delaware, Del. June 9, 1863, and exchanged July 4, 1863. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863. and paroled there July 6, 1863. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file shows him present. No later record.

Hardin, General J.- private March 10, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 6, 1863. Roll for April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him absent without leave. Pension records show he was "Missing at Resaca, Ga. May 1864." No later record.

Hardin, LaFayette A.- private March 10, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 6, 1863. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him present. No later record.

Hardin, Thomas A.- private March 10, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 6, 1863. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him "Absent, Hospital Steward at Enterprise, Miss." Paroled at Meridian, Miss. May 14, 1865. (Died in Forsyth County, Ga. November 9, 1909)

Harris, Alonzo C.- private March 10, 1862. Transferred to Regimental Band July 1, 1862. Returned to company in 1863. Captured at Baker's Creek, Miss. May 16, 1863. Received at City Point, Va. for exchange July 6, 1863. Wounded and captured at Resaca, Ga. May 16, 1864. Died, result amputation of left leg, in General Field Hospital, Dept. of Cumberland, at Resaca, Ga. May 21 or 22, 1864.

Harrison, Alfred G.- private May 15, 1862. Appointed 1st Sergeant in 1863. Wounded at Baker's Creek, Miss. May 16, 1863. Surrendered at Greensboro, N. C. April 26, 1865.

Harrison, J. B.- private May 3, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 7, 1863. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him present. No later record.

Heard, Calvin P.- private March 10, 1862. No later record.

Heard, J. C.- private March 10, 1862. Discharged May 29, 1862.

Henson, Hiram L.- private March 10, 1862. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him present. No later record.

Huggins, S. M.- private May 3, 1863. Wounded and captured at Baker's Creek, Miss. May 16, 1863. Admitted to Prison Hospital there May 1863, "With compound fracture left thigh, which was amputated at upper third in 1863." Pension records do not indicate that thigh was amputated. (Born in Ga. December 15, 1833)

Hughes, William G.- private March 10, 1862 . Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 6, 1863. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him present. No later record.

Hunt, Henry T.- private August 15, 1863. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him present. No later record.

Hutchins, Norman B.- private March 10, 1862. Killed at Baker's Creek, Miss. May 16, 1863.

Hyde, J. D.- private June 5, 1862. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him present. No later record.

Jones, Benjamin G.- private March 10, 1862. Roll to December 31, 1863, last on which borne, shows he was sent to hospital November 15. Returned to duty January 25. No later record.

Jones, Berryman E.- private March 10, 1862. Captured at Baker's Creek, Miss. May 16, 1863. Died at Fort Delaware, Del. June 27, 1863.

Jones, William M.- private March 10, 1862. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him present. No later record.

Julian, Abijah J.- private March 10, 1862. Discharged, furnished Robert R. Gravitt as substitute, October 27, 1862. Enlisted as a private in Co. G 1st Regiment Alabama Cavalry in 1863. Paroled at Charlotte, N. C. May 3, 1865. (Born in Ga.)

Kelly, Sanford V.- private March 10, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 1863. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him absent without leave. No later record.

Kilby, William - private March 10, 1862. Died in hospital July 10, 1862.

King, George T.- private March 10, 1862. Pension records show he was wounded, left leg disabled at Jonesboro, Ga., August 31, 1864. (Born in Ga.)

King, Peyton Ross - private March 10, 1862. Killed at Atlanta, Ga. July 22, 1864. Buried there in Oakland Cemetery.

Lamb, William H.- private March 10, 1862. Wounded in head, left thigh and right hip, and captured at Baker's Creek, Miss. May 16, 1863. Exchanged in 1863. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him "Absent, sent to hospital January 28, 1864." No later record.

Lancaster, Levi - private March 10, 1862. Killed at Vicksburg, Miss. in 1863.

League, B. M.- private May 8, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 6, 1863. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him present. No later record.

League, J. F.- private May 3, 1862. Died in Tennessee October 28, 1862.

Light, Daniel F.- private March 10, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 16, 1863. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him present. Pension records show he was furloughed for 60 days from Camp Hospital near Atlanta, Ga. July 15, 1864. Unable to reach command. Enlisted in Captain Powell's Company, Ga. Militia Cavalry in 1864. Surrendered at Kingston, Ga. May 12, 1865. (Born in Forsyth County, Ga. June 30, 1840)

Mabry, Ephraim W.- private March 10, 1862. Captured in Forsyth County, Ga. in 1864. Deserted in 1864. Received at Military Prison, Louisville, Ky., a Confederate deserter in 1864, where he took oath of allegiance to U. S. Govt., and was released to remain north of Ohio River during war, July 18, 1864.

Mabry, Francis A.- private March 10, 1862. Captured at Atlanta, Ga. August 13, 1864. Released at Camp Chase, O. June 11, 1865.

Martin, Alfred W.- private March 10, 1862. Transferred to Regimental Band July 1, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 1863. Roll dated April 13, 1864, shows him present. No later record.

Martin, P. B.- private April 6, 1863. Died in Fair Grounds Hospital #2, at Atlanta, Ga. April 29, 1864. Buried there in Oakland Cemetery.

Martin, Sevier - private March 10, 1862. Discharged, furnished substitute, June 5, 1862.

Mashburn, Elisha - private March 10, 1862. Wounded and captured at Baker's Creek, Miss. May 16, 1863. Died July 14, 1864.

Mashburn, Henry Thomas - private March 10, 1862. Sent to hospital from Vicksburg, Miss. April 1863. Discharged on account of rheumatism June 24, 1863.

Mashburn, James E.- private March 10, 1862. Captured at

Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 1863. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him present. No later record.

Mashburn, Joseph F.- private March 10, 1862. Captured at Atlanta, Ga. August 13, 1864. Released at Camp Chase, O. May 15, 1866.

Mashburn, Robert F.- private May 3, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 6, 1863. Pension records show he was wounded in knee and captured at Baker's Creek, Miss. May 16, 1863. Sent to Fort Delaware, Del. in 1863. Exchanged in 1863. Wounded in hip at Resaca, Ga. May 25, 1864, and was at home, wounded, close of war. (Born in Forsyth County, Ga. August 31, 1837)

McAfee, George W.- private March 10, 1862. Transferred to Regimental Band July 1, 1862. Killed at Vicksburg, Miss. June 16, 1863.

McCreary, Andrew J.- See private Co. C.

McCreary, William F.- private March 10, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 1863. Captured at Atlanta, Ga. August 13, 1864. Contracted chronic diarrhoea in prison. Released at Camp Chase, O. June 11, 1865.

Merritt, Josiah F.- private May 15, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and died there July 22, 1863.

Merritt, William G.- private March 10, 1862. Died in Empire Hospital at Atlanta, Ga. December 2, 1862.

Millwood, A. J.- private August 13, 1862. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him present. Pension records show he enlisted in "Graham's Battn. and was paroled at Kingston, Ga. May 12, 1865." (Born in South Carolina August 1830)

Monroe, Lans B.- private August 23, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 10, 1863. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him present. No later record.

Vance, J. W.- private May 15, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 6, 1863. Roll dated April 30, 1864, last on file, shows him absent without leave. No later record.

Waldrip, Eli E.- private March 10, 1862. Wounded in left wrist and captured at Missionary Ridge, Tenn. November 25, 1863. Released at Rock Island, Ill. June 20, 1865. (Born in Forsyth County, Ga. February 5, 1834)

Woodliff, George F.- private March 10, 1862. Elected Jr. 2nd Lieutenant November 6, 1862; 2nd Lieutenant. Captured near Atlanta, Ga. August 13, 1864. Released at Johnson's

Island, O. June 16, 1865.

Woodliff, James Wesley - private March 10, 1862. Died at Vicksburg, Miss. in 1863.

Youngblood, John W.- private March 10, 1862. Killed at Resaca, Ga. May 14, 1864. Buried there.
